Kindergarten Registration 2026/2027

In order to be eligible for kindergarten, **children must be 5 years old by December 31, 2026.**

Parents are asked to register their child during school hours or send all information via email to Donna Harris, Administrative Assistant at donnaharris@edu.pe.ca. The registration form, as well as the student questionnaire is available on our school website (www.edu.pe.ca/westroyalty).

If unsure of your school zone, please call the PSB office located in Stratford at 902- 368-6990 or go online to <https://psbusing.princeedwardisland.ca/Eligibility>.

Parents are reminded to bring two pieces of information which verify proof of child's age and verification of home address to the school while registering. You can also scan the documents and send along by e-mail with the registration form/questionnaire. Acceptable documents for proof of age include a birth certificate or PEI Health card. Verification of address would include a bill such as a current utility bill (home address must be listed on the bill).

Welcome to Kindergarten for incoming students and their parents will be held in the spring of 2026. Parents will receive more information via email provided on their child's registration form.
